

GOOD DISTRIBUTION PRACTICES FOR MEDICINES AND MEDICAL DEVICES

Distribution is an integral part of the product's life-cycle involving the procuring, holding, supplying, import and export of medicinal products. It is an important activity in an increasingly complex distribution network that involves many players, including custom areas, and is strictly regulated world-wide to ensure product quality is maintained throughout the product life-cycle.

The sale of human and veterinary medicines and medical devices/IVDs is governed by the Medicines and related substances Act, Act 101 of 1965 and the Pharmacy Act, Act 53 of 1974. Therefore a wholesaler must obtain a license from the South African Health Products Regulatory Authority (SAHPRA) to sell medicines and medical devices in South Africa.
